

Maylandsea Bay Sailing Club House Rules

In addition to the Club Rules and Trust Deed the following House Rules have been approved and apply until further notice:

1. Dogs must be kept under control whilst on club premises.
2. Before Keelboats and Cruisers are moved up or down the ramps on sailing days permission must be obtained from either the Duty Officer or the Sailing Secretary on the day. The East ramp may not be used for craft weighing more than 1 tonne.
3. BAR OPENING HOURS - The bar may be opened by members with permission of the Duty Officer during the hours permitted under the current Licencing Laws
4. No boats or boat trailers are to be parked overnight on the lawn area to the east of the Clubhouse except during Open Meetings.
5. Camping on the Club grounds is allowed but only with the consent of an officer of the Club.
6. Only members over 16 years of age shall be allowed to use the lawn mowers or strimmers.
7. The winch may only be operated by or under the supervision of an authorised club member. The supervisor, who will have been inducted must ensure that the documented safety procedures are observed at all times.
8. Cadets under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult whilst on the Club's premises.
9. Smoking is prohibited throughout the clubhouse (including the upstairs veranda) and other club buildings except in designated areas. Smoking is also prohibited in the area around the garage and fuel store. Smoking on the ground floor veranda, and elsewhere in the club grounds is not prohibited or restricted.
10. Before using a club boat, a member or non-member must obtain the permission of the duty officer (or of a Flag Officer or the race officer of the day, if the duty officer is not available).
